## JAT Gift Theft Rules



All you need to do is buy a gift that is \$20.00 (or less) in value, wrap it and bring it to our JAT party. **Do not put your name on the gift.**

Each person will be given a number (randomly)-the same number will also be put in a hat. An impartial person will be chosen to randomly draw the numbers from the hat.

Here are the rules:

The person with the first number drawn must choose a gift from the pile. The next person whose number is drawn then has the option of picking a present from the pile or they can take (steal) the present that the first person picked. If someone steals the first person's gift he/she must choose another from the pile. The next number is then drawn and this person can then either take a present from the pile, or can take either of the presents already taken. The cycle continues until all presents have been removed from the pile.

You may not steal back the gift you just had stolen from you right away; you must wait a turn until someone steals from you again.

A gift may be stolen only 2 times, after that it is safe and cannot be stolen again.

You don't have to steal a gift, but it makes it a bit more fun.

You must supply a gift to play our game.

Summary:

- Buy a gift \$20.00 (or less): nice or tacky.
- Wrap your anonymous gift - no names on your gift, bring it to the party or leave by the 2nd floor Christmas tree the morning of the 15th.
- At the party you will get a number, a corresponding number goes in the hat to be drawn.
