Bio: Pat Camp is an Associate Professor, Department of Physical Therapy, University of British Columbia. She holds a Principal Investigator position at the UBC Centre for Heart Lung Innovation and is affiliated with the St. Paul's Hospital Pulmonary Rehabilitation Program. Her research interests are focused on Indigenous lung health, pulmonary rehabilitation, health equity, and accessible respiratory care.

She has published over 100 peer-reviewed articles, currently holds 4 CIHR project grants and 1 team grant, has mentored many graduate, undergraduate, and MPT students, ran a podcast for 4 years focused on Pulmonary Rehabilitation & academic life, and has given several presentations and workshops on academic writing productivity at conferences and research universities.
