"St Paul's Foundation is the fundraising arm of Providence Health Care, working with private donors, corporations and other foundations to fund patient care, equipment, programs and research at St Paul's, Mt St Joseph and all PHC residential care sites.

We're nearly finished our 5-year, \$225M fundraising campaign, which included \$125M for the new St. Paul's acute care hospital, and \$100M for programs, research and other initiatives. So what's next? And how can HLI benefit from philanthropic support going forward?

St. Paul's Foundation is in the midst of collecting input across all areas of PHC to help determine what the next 5 years of fundraising priorities will look like. These years are our bridge to the new St. Paul's campus, and are our opportunity to fund the people, equipment and programs needed to set us up for success at the new site. SPF is committed to raising \$50M for the CSRC. How can we support the research and people who will be within that building? This talk will provide an overview of our goals, challenges and opportunities over the next 5 years, and how SPF hopes to partner with HLI to provide research funding"
