“Myocarditis was considered a severe and often fatal cause of heart failure for most of the 20th century. MRI and PET imaging revealed that chest pain and arrhythmias with normal heart function are frequent manifestations of myocarditis. In the past 2 years Sars-CoV-2 and the mRNA vaccines have raised new questions about the mechanisms and clinical management of immune-mediated cardiac injury.”
