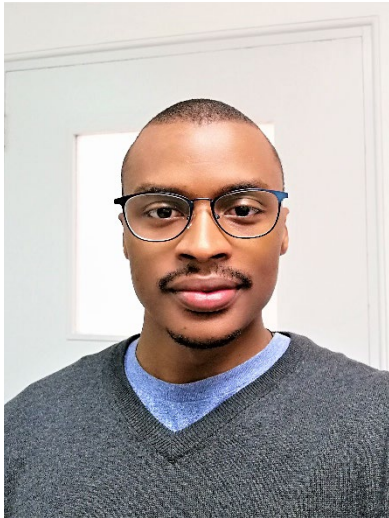

Community members and leaders need information on the air quality of members’ homes and the relationship between air quality and respiratory symptoms that people report to mitigate air quality deficiencies and improve lung health. This project is a response to the Community Advisory Committee requesting that in addition to lung function testing that the research team recommended during the planning meeting, indoor air quality be assessed as a way of determining factors that affect lung health.”
